Liberty Introduces Intelix PoE+ Ethernet Switch

Four and eight port switches expand entry into IP-based AV distribution.

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colorado—March 4, 2015—Liberty AV Solutions announced the first Intelix Ethernet switch series, INT-IPSW1100. These products are designed to be paired with the INT-IPEX1000 series extenders, but also function as typical unmanaged switches.

The four port (INT-IPSW1104) and eight port (INT-IPSW1108) switches are 10/100BaseT switches with 1 Gbps backplanes, which support the 802.3 af/at Power over Ethernet (PoE) standard to provide up to 25.5 watts of power per numbered port. The Uplink port supports up to 100BaseT Ethernet connections, but does not provide power via PoE.

The selector switch on the front of the devices defines two modes of operation: Default and Isolate. Default mode allows all devices connected to the switch to communicate with each other. Isolate mode only allows the numbered ports to communicate with the Uplink port.

The INT-IPSW1100 series switches are expected to be available Q2 2015 from authorized Liberty AV Solutions/Intelix dealers across North America.
